Victor's Hemiaccoyo Grand Finale



Beige and nearly four years of age, Grand Finale is aptly named – he is the final offspring of Pperuvian Accoyo Victor, and is the full sibling of the late Vic Jr., herd sire Valedar, Supreme Female Champion (out of 125 females at 2001 IAO Show) Valedara, and White Female Champion Valia (Level V AWE). In his two years of showing, the results have been stellar, but not unexpected due to his lineage. 2006 Alpacapalooza 1st Full Fleece Beige Juvenile, 2006 Alpacapalooza Light Male Champion, 2006 AOBA National Show Composite Light Male Reserve Champion, 2007AWE 2nd Beige Yearling Male, 2007 AWE 2nd Beige Yearling Fleece, 2007 AWE Light Reserve Champion Fleece, 2007 AWE Best Crimp Special Award. Grand Finale's first offspring are due this spring, and once they hit the ground, he will be elevated to the title of "Foundation Herd Sire". As is typical with the Victor-Sara lineage, his shear weights reflect his tremendous density and staple length – over ten pounds as a yearling, and over thirteen pounds as a

three year old. Timberland has held onto to this bloodline very tightly, and have retained all but a very few as our foundation stock.
