## Vic Jr's Hemiaccoyo Paladin



Paladin is a fitting tribute to his sire, Victor's Vic Jr., who was the firstborn offspring of Sara's Sahara and Victor. Vic Jr. was much beloved at Timberland for the all too short eight years of his life as we believed that he, of all of the Victor offspring, most closely resembled his sire. One of Jr.'s last offspring was Paladin. Paladin's dam, Hemingway's Pearl, is without a doubt, one of the most valued foundation females in the Timberland herd. Pearl is truly one of the most prepotent alpacas – she has produced offspring with the finest and brightest of fleeces regardless of the sire that she is bred to.

Paladin's fiber stats from two months through 12 months of age are remarkable (13.8 AFD; 3.1 SD; 66 % Curvature; 11-12 crimps/inch). It has the closest resemblance to Merino. His first two offspring were born in 2008 – a very fine, bright fleece on a white female cria, and a finely crimped, medium silver grey male cria that was a surprise and happily welcomed color. Paladin is now co-owned with Long Acres Alpaca Farm in Pennsylvania, and will be residing with Mike and Sarah Donahoe from September through May.
